The Hoatzin in its nest

The hoatzin bird lives only in the Amazon jungle and is a very interesting bird. It can grow about 60 cm long and weighs about 800 grams. Hoatzin birds live in groups of 10 to 40 birds. They build nests in trees near lakes and they don't fly much.

The hoatzin has got another name – the stink bird. It got this name because it smells bad! The hoatzin eats only plants and spends about four hours a day eating. The food stays in the bird's stomach for a long time and produces a terrible smell.

The local people don't hunt the hoatzin because of its smell. But for some animals, such as capuchin monkeys, the hoatzin is a tasty meal. When a predator comes near them, the older birds make a lot of noise. The young ones then jump into water and hide there until the predator leaves the area.

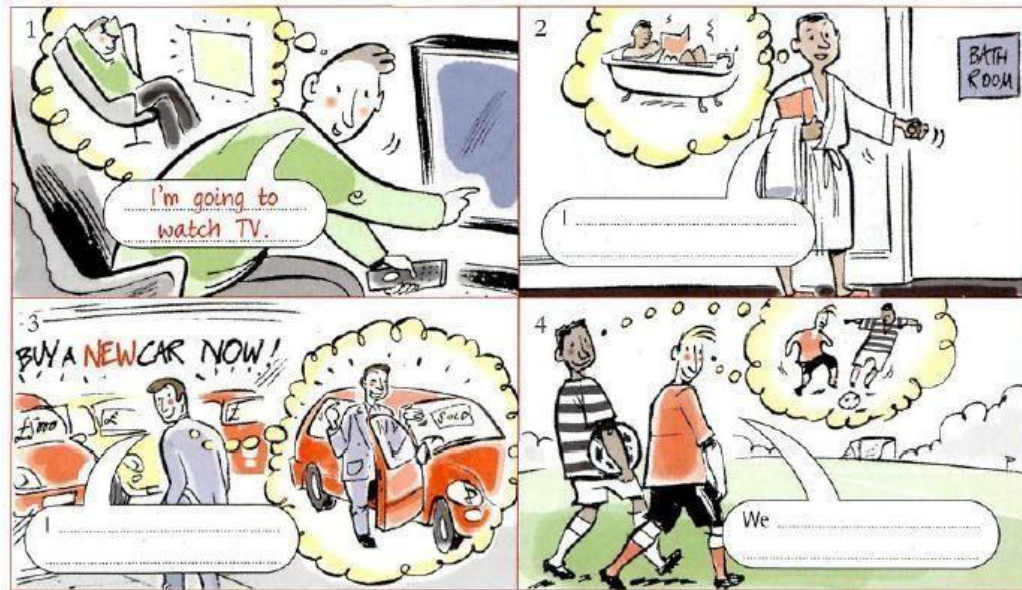
